Fall Wind Day 2017

Wednesday, September 20th from 9am-2pm

CCCC is expecting about 110 total wind energy students (55 new students) by enrollment in August. They have hired more instructors and are now at six full time wind instructors. All of their Spring 2017 graduates have been hired or are on summer **internships** with the possibility of being hired at the end of the internship.

CCCC's sUAS (drone) program is really taking off (pun intended). They have filled two beginning level classes and see more and more industries utilizing this technology. CCCC has just purchased their first fixed wing sUAS. It is an AgEagle manufactured in Neodesha, KS. They are partnering with the CCCC Ag Department in the area of precision agriculture. They have also entered into a sUAS simulation software partnership with Zephyr Software by Little Arms Studios and another partnership with Unmanned Safety Institute, a subsidiary of ARGUS International, for sUAS curriculum and certifications.
