Smoky Hill Education Service Center was founded on July 1, 1990, in Salina, Kansas, to benefit member school districts and educational institutions

The center serves more than **50 school districts** across **25 counties**, serving **2,700 teachers and administrators** responsible for the education of more than **31,000 Kansas students**.
